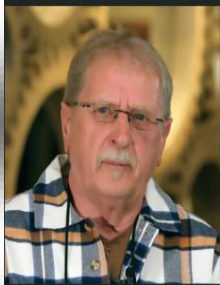

Centre, Seniors Housing, landscaping, dust control, subsidizing business or developers, policing, fire protection. Please let me know....
